Overview

The AWG sizing system is based on the number of times the wire is pulled thinner. For example, a Zero Gauge (0 AWG) has a diameter of 0.325 inches.

What is a solar wire?

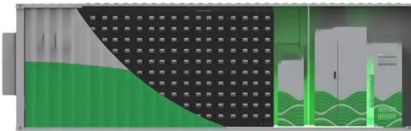
Solar wires (or cables) are electrical conductors that connect the photovoltaic cells within the solar panels to the rest of the solar power system. They carry the direct current generated by solar panels to the inverter or battery in the power station.

Can you use other wires on a solar panel?

Solar panels 50W and above often use 10 gauge AWG, which allows 30A current to move from a single PV module. Can You Use Other Wires Other Than Solar Wires on a PV Module System?

As long as the voltage drop is less than 5%, you can use any wire. Preferably though you should only use wiring designed for solar panels.

For example, if you were wiring a 50W low energy 12v appliance, you would use $I = P/V$. That's $50W/12v = 4.17A$. Your cable would need to be able to safely carry slightly more than 4.2 amps. If in doubt, going up a cable size is usually safe ...

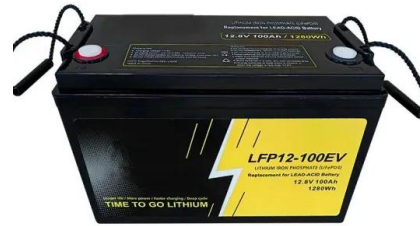
