The production of wind energy in Brazil hit a record in 2021, exceeding 20 gigawatts of installed capacity and becoming the third largest source of electricity generation in the country, according to data from the monthly energy bulletin released by the federal government.

Where does Brazil rank in accumulated wind power capacity?

In 2022, Brazil kept its position in the accumulated wind power capacity World Ranking, prepared by GWEC (Global Wind Energy Council). In the year's new installed capacity list Brazil ranks third, for the third consecutive year.

How favourable are Brazilian winds for wind power generation?

The favourable quality of Brazilian winds for wind power generation stands out globally. Brazil has a capacity factor (wind productivity) that is above average, as shown below. The Northeast accounts for 80% of Brazilian wind energy farms.

Where does wind energy come from in Brazil?

Wind energy represents about 11% of the Brazilian energy matrix, the third most common. The Brazilian Northeast is the region that stands out in the production of this type of power, due to offering favorable climatic conditions, with strong and constant winds.

Which state produces the most wind energy in Brazil?

The state of Rio Grande do Norte is the largest producer of wind energy in the country, and its installed capacity is expected to grow in the coming months. The wind is more intense from June to December, coinciding with the months with less intensity of rain.

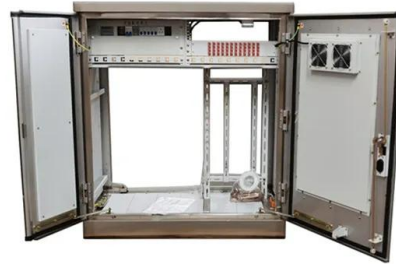

Renewable energy in Brazil

According to Brazil's Energy Master-plan 2016-2026 (PDE2016-2026), Brazil is expected to install 18,5GW of additional wind power generation, 84% in the North-East and 14% in the South. [1] Brazil started focusing on developing alternative sources of energy, mainly sugarcane ethanol, after the oil shocks in the 1970s.

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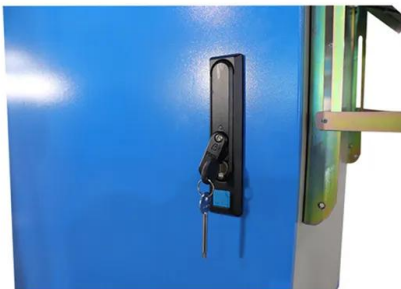

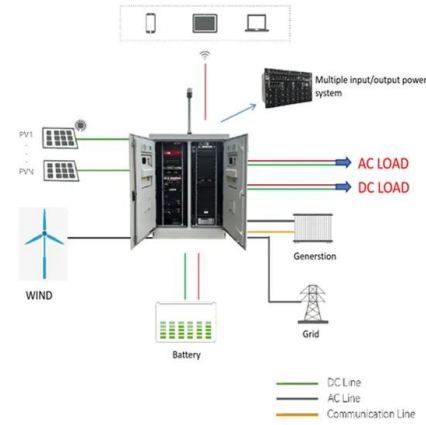

Brazil Tops 21 GW of Installed Wind Capacity

Brazil's installed wind power capacity has reached 21.03 GW, national wind energy association Abeeolica announced on Tuesday. The country now has 777 operational wind parks with a total of 9,042 wind turbines, producing enough power to meet the monthly demand of 28.8 million households.



Brazil Wind Energy: Notable Output but Inaccurate Forecasts

Wind energy production was 10% lower on average than P50 and very close to P90 levels in the last two years across Fitch-rated standalone wind projects in Brazil. The average P50 and P90



difference for the rated portfolio is in the range of 10% to 17%, indicating that the wind studies carry significant uncertainty.

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
