Can Forsythia be planted under photovoltaic panels



Overview

Can a forsythia plant be planted under a tree?

Forsythia plants enjoy plenty of sunshine, so don't plant them under deciduous or evergreen trees. A few will grow well against a fence or wall, and even a north-facing wall in many areas. However, most are best as specimens planted at the back of garden borders to give them space to grow.

Can a forsythia grow in a pot?

The most compact varieties are suitable for large pots. Forsythias thrive in a wide range of soils apart from waterlogged or extremely dry soil, although the best results are in soil that is fertile and well-drained. You can plant forsythia at any time of year but it's best to plant in autumn or winter, when the plants are dormant.

How do you grow a forsythia plant?

Plant with the top of the root ball at the same depth as the soil level, firm in, and water well to settle the soil around the roots. For growing forsythia in containers, use a John Innes type of potting compost. Once established, forsythia needs little care apart from pruning once flowering has finished.

Can a forsythia grow in shade?

Forsythia plants appreciate plenty of sunshine so if trees or larger plants growing nearby begin to cast shade, take action – pruning shrubs around your forsythia will let in more light. Forsythia will often continue to grow in increasing shade, but will become spindly and flowering will become thin.

Where can I buy a forsythia plant?

Forsythias are widely sold in garden centres, nurseries and online by mail order. They are usually container-grown plants, in 2–3 litre pots, although larger plants may sometimes be available. When selecting a plant to buy:

When should I plant forsythia?

You can plant forsythia at any time of year but it's best to plant in autumn or winter, when the plants are dormant.
