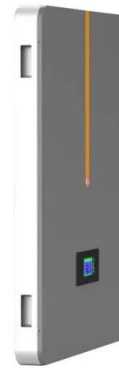

The Caymans are comprised of three islands--Grand Cayman, Little Cayman, and Cayman Brac. The islands are the peaks of several underwater mountains in the Cayman Ridge. There is little, if any, proof of indigenous people on the islands, and they were mainly uninhabited prior to the 17th Century.
