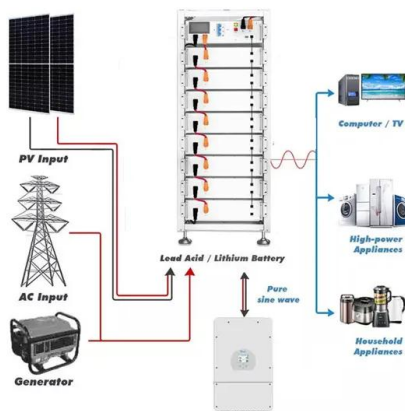

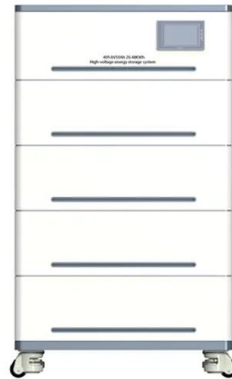

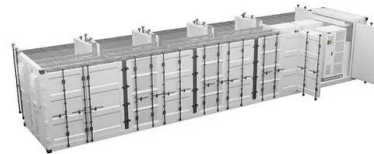


## Power Africa Supports the First Energy Sector Public-Private
