Overview

Do I need planning permission to install solar panels?

Solar PV installations are considered a 'permitted development' and will generally not need planning permission. However, in some cases, such as in Conservation Areas and on Listed Buildings, planning permission may be required. For planning advice please visit the link below. Do I need a DNO application if I have solar panels?

If you have installed solar panels on your home and they are generating electricity, you need to let your regional DNO know. The size of your solar installation (above or below 3.68kWp) determines whether you need to make a DNO application before any work is carried out. This is because the DNO has to monitor fluctuations in the electricity grid.

How do I connect my solar panel system to the electrical grid?

To connect your solar panel system to the electrical grid and benefit from the Smart Export Guarantee (SEG), you will need to speak with your local District Network Operator (DNO). If your solar panel installation involves work on a shared or party wall, you may need to comply with the Party Wall Act.

Can solar panels be installed without a planning system?

Changes to permitted development rights rules will mean more homeowners and businesses will be able to install solar panels on their roofs without going through the planning system. Currently those who have to go through the planning system are having to wait over eight weeks and face extra costs.

How do I choose a solar panel installer?

Firstly, it's really important to ensure you engage a solar panel installer that is registered with an appropriate certification scheme. Check if the installer you wish to use is registered with a Competent Persons Scheme or through a certified body such as the Microgeneration Certification Scheme (MCS).

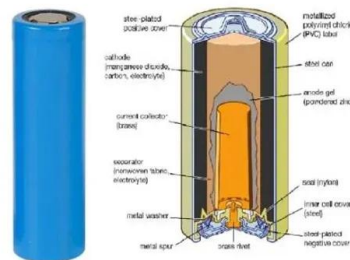
