Overview

What makes a ground-mount Foundation the right fit for a solar project?

Soil composition, local climate conditions, module size, array tilt and other features of the proposed site and array influence what makes a ground-mount foundation the right fit for an individual solar project. “Arrays may be mounted on driven beams, anchor systems, ballasts or hybrid racking systems,” said Bill Taylor, CEO of DCE Solar.

What types of foundations are used for solar panels?

Different foundations are used based on the site’s soil conditions, local regulations, and project scale. Concrete Ballast: Concrete blocks or pads are strategically placed on the ground to provide weight and stability to the solar array. This non-penetrating foundation is often used when soil penetration is restricted or prohibited.

Should solar panels be mounted on the ground?

Mounting solar panels on the ground instead of on a roof has benefits and drawbacks. As its name suggests, a ground-mounted solar system is a free-standing solar array mounted on the ground using either a rigid metal frame or atop a single pole.

Can a concrete foundation be used for a solar array?

Concrete foundations. Repurposed brownfield sites, capped landfills, and designated wetland sites are ideal for ground-mounted solar arrays, but they require foundation designs to be minimally invasive. These kinds of sites can use concrete foundation racking systems that do not disturb the ground underneath.

Are bifacial solar panels better than ground-mounted solar panels?

Ground-mounted solar panels are more efficient than roof-mounted solar panels, as achieving the best angle and direction is easier when no roof is in

the way. This setup also enables the installation of bifacial solar panels, which can turn more sunlight into power.

Do I need planning permission for a ground-mounted solar system?

This means that most homeowners who want to install a ground-mounted solar panels system large enough to power their entire home will need planning permission. Homeowners in listed buildings will also need planning permission for their solar panels, regardless of the size of the ground-mounted solar system.
