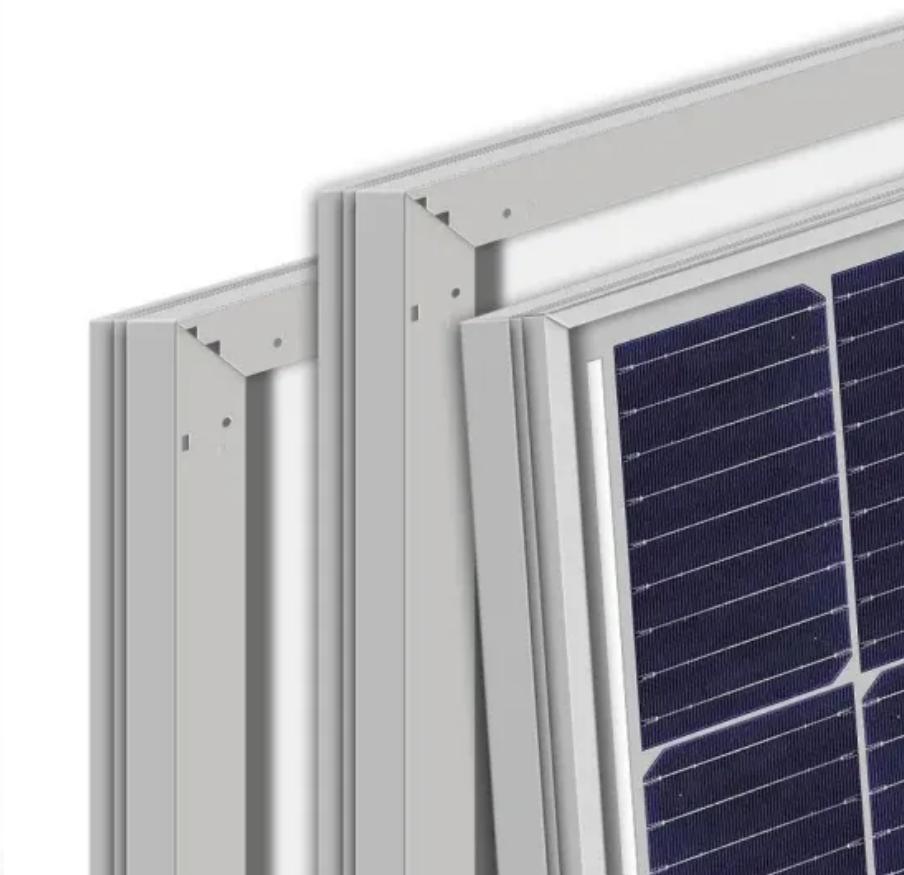

St. Vincent and the Grenadines

St. Vincent is entirely volcanic and Rowley (1978a) observed that there is "roughly an even distribution of lava flows and pyroclastics". However, recent mapping suggest that there is much variation in this distribution, so that at some centres (e.g. South-East Volcanics) lavas are dominant while at others (e.g. Grand Bonhomme Volcanic Centre), volcaniclastics predominate.

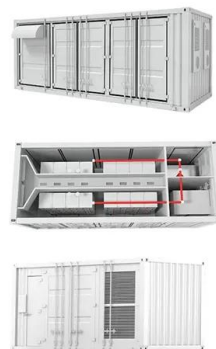

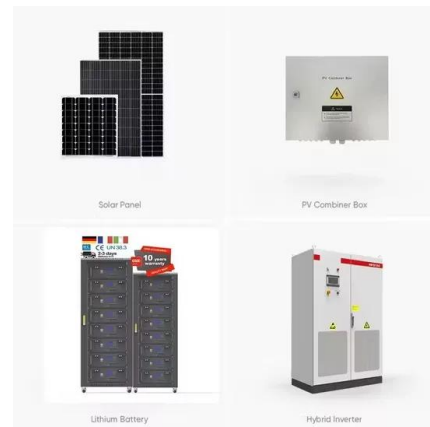
