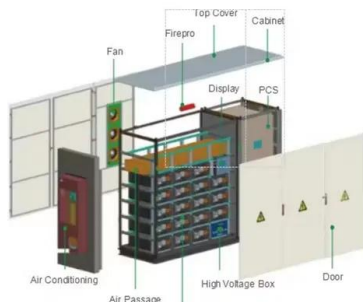

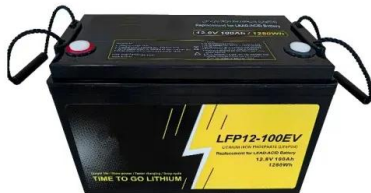

Scatec reaches financial close for BESS facility in South Africa



The company is preparing to begin the construction of the project, Africa's first and largest standalone dispatchable BESS system, near Kathu in the Northern Cape. Scatec will hold a 51% equity share in the project, with Perpetua Mogobe (RF) owning 46.5%, and a holding company of the Mogobe Local Community Trust having the remaining 2.5%.

Mogobe BESS has a 15-year PPA with the National Transmission Company of South Africa (NTCSA). The NTCSA is a subsidiary of Eskom Holdings created through the ongoing unbundling of Eskom - South Africa's national utility - into three separate entities responsible, respectively, for electricity generation, transmission, and distribution.

Scatec Unveils Major Energy Storage in South Africa

The estimated cost of the Mogobe BESS project stands at ZAR 3bn (US\$170m), with the primary funding -- about 90% -- sourced from non-recourse project debt. This considerable sum, specifically ZAR 2.7bn (US\$154m), is being facilitated through the Standard Bank of South Africa, serving as the mandated lead arranger.



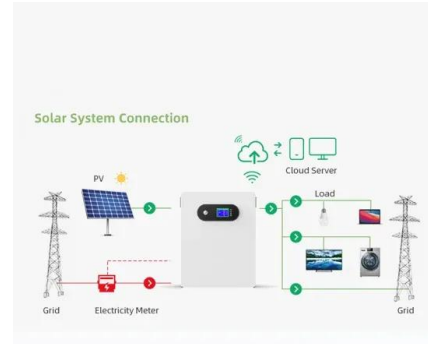
