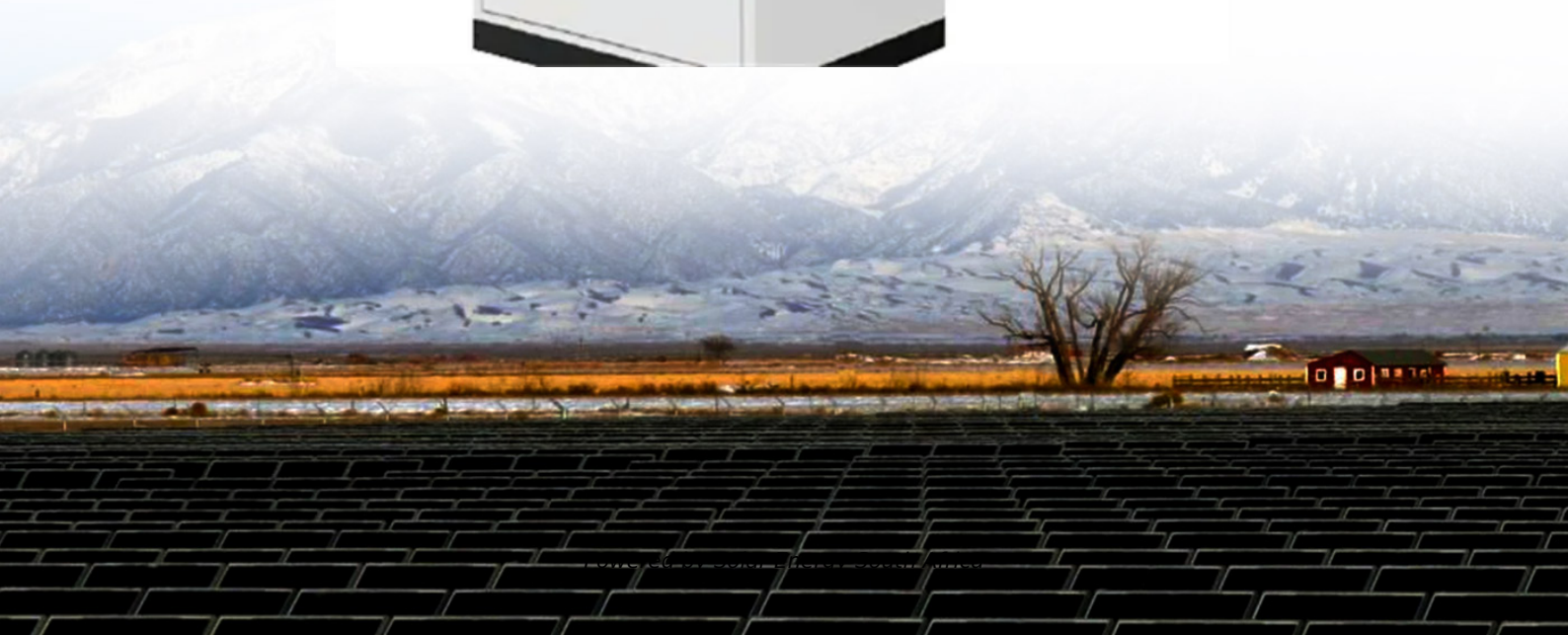

The leaders of Germany's three major political factions have agreed to cut an unspecified amount of solar spending, among other initiatives, to plug a €60 billion (\$64 billion) budget shortfall triggered by a German federal court ruling in November.

What will Germany do with a new solar project?

With the latest scheme, Germany plans to hold more tenders targeting bigger capacities for rooftop and ground-mounted solar, onshore wind and biomethane plants as well as innovation projects.

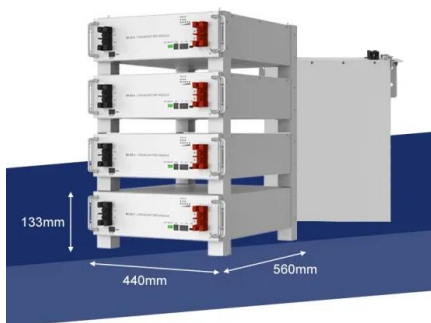
