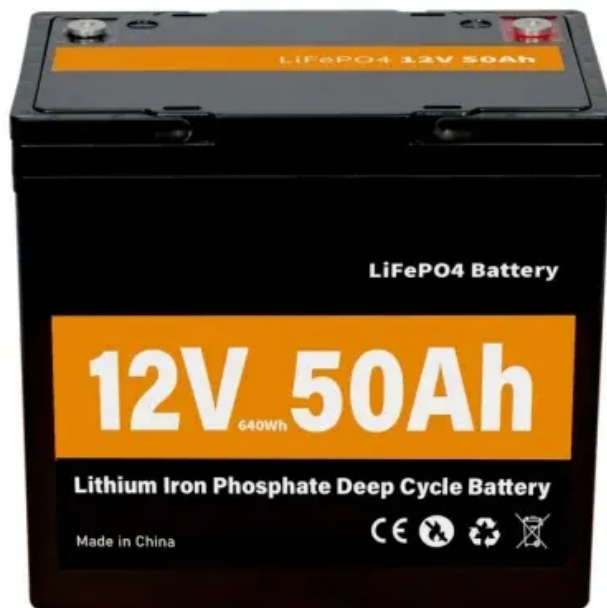

Overview

Where can a ground-mounted solar panel be installed?

Ground-mounted solar panels can be installed anywhere with good sun exposure and sufficient amounts of open space – a minimum of 350 square feet is usually required. Ground-mounted solar panels are also known as backyard solar panels, free-standing solar panels, and ground-mount PV systems.

How much space does a ground-mounted solar panel take up?

One ground-mounted solar panel only takes up around 2 m². However, it needs to be installed at least 5 m away from your house to ensure it won't fall under any shade cast by the house. A garden that's around 15-20 m² should have enough space for around one to three ground-mounted panels.

Are ground-mounted solar panels better than rooftop solar?

Ground-mounted solar panel systems usually cost about 10% more than rooftop solar. You need a lot more equipment, which adds up. But ground-mounted panels also let you dial them into exactly the right direction and angle to maximize sun exposure, which can increase your electric bill savings over time.

Which solar panels should you choose for your garden?

However, if space is limited, you can opt for smaller panels, such as portable solar panels, or even mini solar panels that power garden lights, all of which you can set up yourself. Solar panel pergolas are also something those with a modest amount of space should consider.

Do garden solar panels need professional installation?

Garden solar panels can refer to a variety of different solar panel setups, and not all of them require professional installation. If you have a garden with a lot of space, you can install ground-mounted solar panels (solar panels that are

fixed into the ground).

Can a ground-mounted solar panel power a three-bedroom house?

As we've noted previously, a ground-mounted solar panel system large enough to power a three-bedroom house requires at least 50 m² of space. Ground-mounted solar panel setups larger than 9m² also require planning permission, and there are limits on what you can do if you live in a conservation area.
