How long can breast milk storage box be kept in the freezer



Overview

Everything you need to know about expressing and storing your breast milk, including tips on hand expressing and electric breast pumps, and how to freeze, defrost and warm breast milk.

You can express milk by hand or with a breast pump. How often you express your milk, and how much you express, will depend on why you're doing it. Sometimes it takes a little while for.

You can store breast milk in a sterilised container or in special breast milk storage bags: in the fridge for up to 8 days at 4C or lower (you can buy fridge thermometers online) – if you're not sure of the temperature of your fridge.

Some find it easier to express milk by hand, especially in the first few days or weeks. It also means you can express without needing a pump.

There are 2 different types of breast pump: manual (hand-operated) and electric. Manual pumps are cheaper but may not be as quick as an electric.

How long can breast milk be stored in the fridge?

Breast milk in the refrigerator: up to 8 days at 4°C or lower, or up to 3 days in a fridge above 4°C 2. Store it in the back of the fridge, not in the door. Breast milk freezer storage: up to 6 months, as long as it is stored in fully sterilised bottles and the freezer's temperature is -18°C or lower 2.

How long can you keep breast milk in a freezer?

As long as the temperature of the freezer is 0°F or below, the type of freezer does not matter. The temperature of kitchen freezers is typically 0° F. Deep freezers and chest freezers may be colder than 0°F. Breast milk can be stored at 0° F or colder for up to 12 months, although using it within 6 months is best.

How do you store frozen breast milk?

Breast milk can be stored in a sterilised container, or special storage bags – remember to label and date it. Store it in small quantities to avoid wasting

any. Your breast milk can then be kept: The best way to defrost frozen breast milk is by leaving it in the fridge to thaw out completely before use.

How long can breast milk be stored in a cooler bag?

For these occasions, keep an insulated cooler bag ready to store breast milk. Once it's been cooled in the fridge, breast milk can be carried in a cooler bag for up to 24 hours, provided that the bag also contains ice packs 2. We recommend that you start expressing a few days before you need to.

Can breast milk be stored in a sterilised container?

You can store breast milk in a sterilised container or in special breast milk storage bags: Breast milk that's been cooled in the fridge can be carried in a cool bag with ice packs for up to 24 hours. Storing breast milk in small quantities will help avoid waste. If you're freezing it, make sure you label and date it first.

How long can milk be stored in the fridge?

It can be stored in the fridge (at a temperature of 4 degrees Celsius) for between 4 and 8 days. It can also be kept in a freezer for up to 6 months. Milk needs to be placed in either the fridge or freezer as soon after expressing as possible. Try to use a new container every time you express.

You can store breast milk in a refrigerator with a freezer that has a separate door (0°F or -18°C) for up to 12 months, although using it within six months is preferable. The earlier you use up your breast milk, the better, ...

Storing breast milk

Store it in small quantities to avoid wasting any. Your breast milk can then be kept: at the back of the fridge - not the door - for up to 8 days (at 4°C or colder) in the ice compartment of the fridge for up to 2 weeks; in the freezer for up to 6 ...

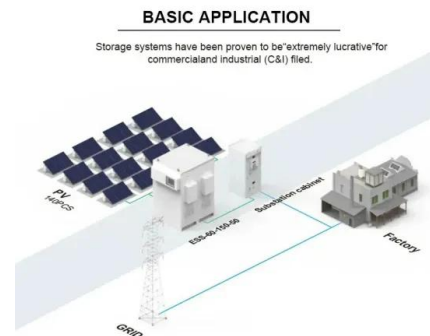
