Terraced houses typically have less roof space than a semi-detached or detached property, especially when the space is also occupied with a chimney. This means that some of the larger solar power systems, with an output above 5kw, simply wont fit in the space.

Where should solar panels be installed on a terraced house?

On terraced houses, because of the limited space, the solar panels will need to be installed either on the front or the back of the property. One thing you should consider when making this decision is not the aesthetics, but the side of the roof that will get the most sun.

Is your house suitable for solar PV?

"Several factors can be considered when determining if your house is suitable for solar PV," says John Gilham. "Here are are the key factors: "Ideally, solar panels work best facing south. They capture the solar energy from dawn until dusk.

Will a smaller solar power system fit in a terraced home?

This means that some of the larger solar power systems, with an output above 5kw, simply won't fit in the space. However, in a terraced home it is likely that you will be using less power than a larger home, so a smaller solar power system should still meet all your power needs.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system – so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.
