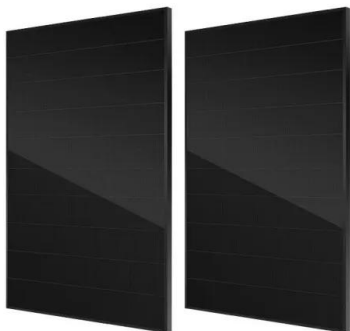
Flexx10
