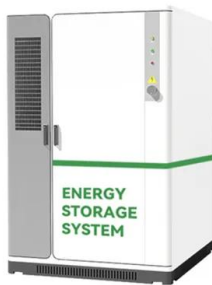


May Weather in French Polynesia French Polynesia

The wetter season lasts 6.0 months, from October 31 to April 28, with a greater than 32% chance of a given day being a wet day. In French Polynesia during September average daily high temperatures are level around 84°F and the fraction of time spent overcast or mostly cloudy increases from 24% to 38%. The average daily incident shortwave solar energy in French Polynesia is gradually increasing during September, rising by 0.5 kWh, from 5.9 kWh to 6.4 kWh,

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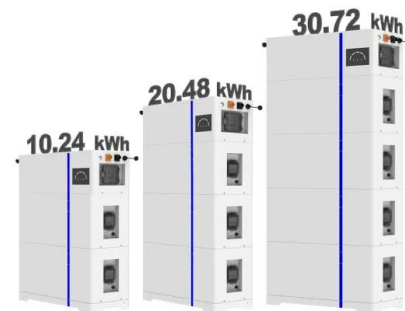

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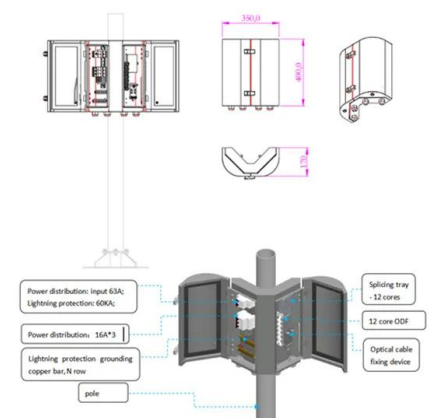
