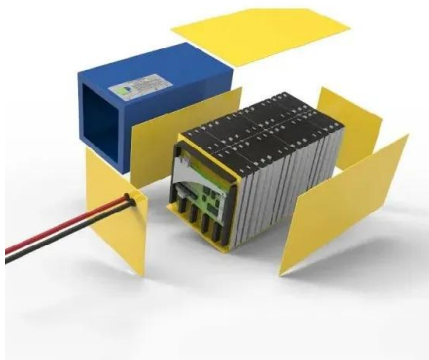

## Namibia 18th most attractive investment destination in Africa

Namibia has been ranked 18th out of 31 jurisdictions on the African continent in terms of investment attractiveness. Rand Merchant Bank (RMB) scored Namibia a lowly -0.05. This score places Namibia unfavourably compared to countries such as Benin, which is ranked 17th, Rwanda at 16th and Botswana in 15th place.
