What is cable-supported photovoltaic (PV)?

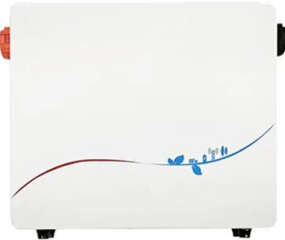
Cable-supported photovoltaic (PV) modules have been proposed to replace
