Price of solar energy inia Albania



Overview

Solar power produced by photovoltaic plants with an installed power capacity up to 2MW will be purchased by the Albanian government for a price of Euro 100 per Megawatt.

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Aga Solar and Notus Energy have a project of 55.7 MW at €0.0499/kWh, while Solar PV, Gr ALBANIA, Enterprise Albania, and RAB proposed 29.13 MW at €0.0548/kWh.

Solar PV, Gr Albania, Enterprise Albania and RAB won 29.13 MW at EUR 54.8 per MWh. A consortium comprising Kosovo*-based Eco Park Group, Birra Peja Vlorem Energy, Future Energy Trading and Exchange Dynamic is eligible for a 15-year CfD contract for 41.8 MW at a price of EUR 56.11 per MWh.

The Albanian authorities have set a ceiling price of €0.05997 (\$0.06522)/kWh for the auction. The deadline for submitting project proposals is May 17. Albania currently subsidizes large-scale.

The maximum acceptable price is EUR 59.97 per MWh, so project developers with the lowest bids will be selected until fulfilling a total of 300 MW in capacity. Albania needs solar, wind power to balance hydroelectric production
How much does a solar power project cost in Albania?

Still, the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy awarded 283.9 MW. The lowest offer came in at EUR 39.7 per MWh, against a starting level of EUR 59.97 per MWh. Eight consortiums won 15-year power purchase agreements (PPAs) today in Albania for their solar power projects as the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy opened their bids.

How many MW of solar capacity will Albania have?

The Albanian authorities aim to allocate 300 MW of solar capacity through a

new procurement exercise, with projects ranging from 10 MW to 100 MW. Solar Energy of Albania (SENA) aims to develop a 12.9 MW floating solar project on a lake in northwestern Albania, next to an existing hydropower plant.

What was the lowest bid at Albania's solar power auction?

The lowest bid at Albania's solar power auction came in at EUR 39.7 per MWh, against a starting level of EUR 59.97 per MWh.

Is there solar energy in Albania?

There is a large potential of solar energy in Albania. Solar radiation is 1.7-2 times higher than in Germany. About 99.5% of energy in Albania is produced by hydropower plants (in summer there is not such rainfall). Many small power plants can not operate during the summer months, as water is needed for agriculture.

Could solar power reduce Albania's reliance on energy imports?

Albanian researchers say that solar could be key to reducing Albania's reliance on energy imports, but the nation will need to invest in grid infrastructure, streamline laws, and enhance access to funding to support deployment.

What quota is available for photovoltaic projects in Albania?

Albania invited investors to qualify their photovoltaic projects for an upcoming tender for 15-year contracts for difference. The available quota is 300 MW.

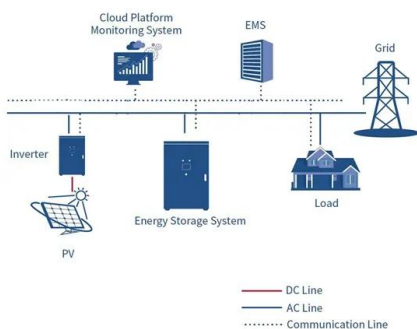

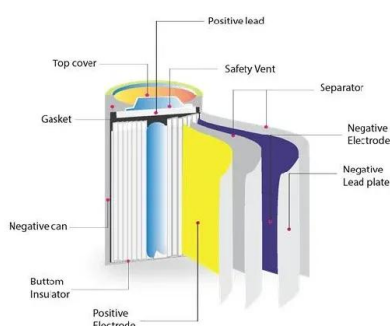

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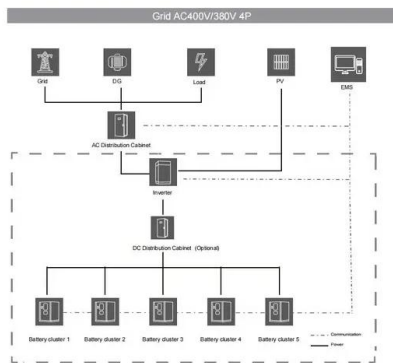
