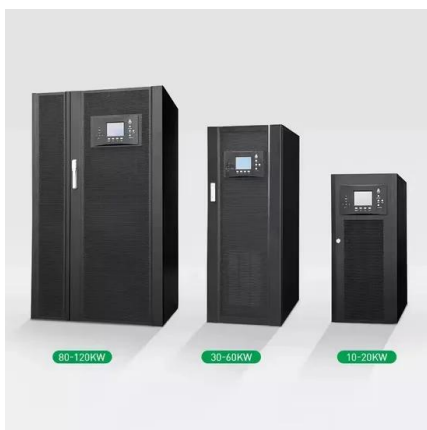


Ruwais LNG will push UAE up the energy table
