Should I keep more panels when installing photovoltaics

Should I add more solar panels?

Having said that, adding just one or two more panels might be more trouble than it's worth. The size of your current system may influence how many more solar panels you plan to add. If your solar installation stays below 3.68kW (or 16 Amps) generation with the added panels, there shouldn't be any problem.

Can I install more solar panels than needed?

Though there are some exceptions, installing more panels than necessary likely won't benefit you. If you're looking into installing solar, one of the biggest questions will be what size your panel system should be.

Should I increase the number of solar panels on my home?

Depending on the age of your current system, increasing the amount of solar panels on your home may come with fitting or cost implications. Can I add more solar panels to my roof?

Once you've determined your energy use, you can calculate the amount of additional panels you require. Increasing the amount of solar panels isn't

solely determined by how much space you have remaining on your roof. The size of the panels you currently have installed will impact whether you can add more to your system.

Should I add more solar panels to my inverter?

As they're accurately sized to the solar installation, adding more panels will probably exceed the amount of electricity your inverter can process. Since string inverters have an average lifespan of 10 years, try to coincide the installation of your extra panels with replacing your inverter to save money.

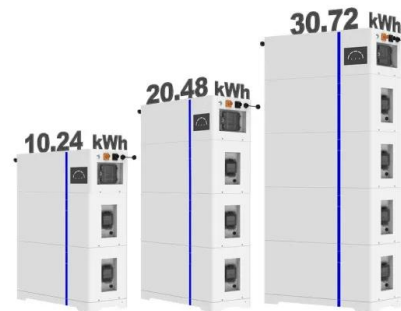
