Solar power plants go to the countryside



Overview

Are rural areas leading the way on solar power generation?

New CPRE analysis reveals that homes in the countryside are leading the way on solar power generation. 48 of the 50 English parliamentary constituencies with the highest domestic solar generation capacity are in rural areas, while all 200 of those with the lowest are in towns and cities.

Could Botley West be the UK's largest solar farm?

That includes sources like solar — and the proposed Botley West Solar Farm, just down the road from this Oxfordshire village hall. Botley West, if built, would be the U.K.'s largest solar development, a mega farm covering 18 kilometers of countryside, with the potential to power 330,000 homes.

Are solar farms a threat to our countryside?

Solar farms continue to hit the headlines, especially in local media. We're regularly asked for help in challenging a solar proposal that would be an industrial scale intrusion into the landscape. But, climate breakdown poses the biggest threat to our countryside and we need renewable energy. How can the two be reconciled?

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Which countries have solar panels?

In contrast to the UK's approach, France has announced plans to fast track renewable energy by mandating car parks nationwide be covered by solar panels. And in 2020, 83% of newly installed solar capacity in Germany was on rooftops. Rooftops are the best place for solar panels for our landscapes and wildlife, too.

Could a solar farm power 10000 homes in Somerset?

A solar farm designed to power up to 10,000 Somerset homes is to be built

near protected countryside in Dorset. Elgin Energy has got permission to construct the solar farm in North Perrott, near Crewkerne. South Somerset District Council has approved the proposals, arguing the solar farm's impact can be mitigated.

Where should new solar panels go?

It's clear that we need to see lots more solar energy being generated in this country, especially as fossil fuel imports have become so expensive. The real issue is where new solar panels should go. At CPRE we believe the best answer to this question is surprisingly simple – on our roofs.

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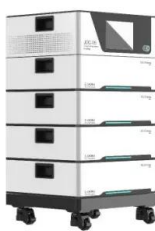
