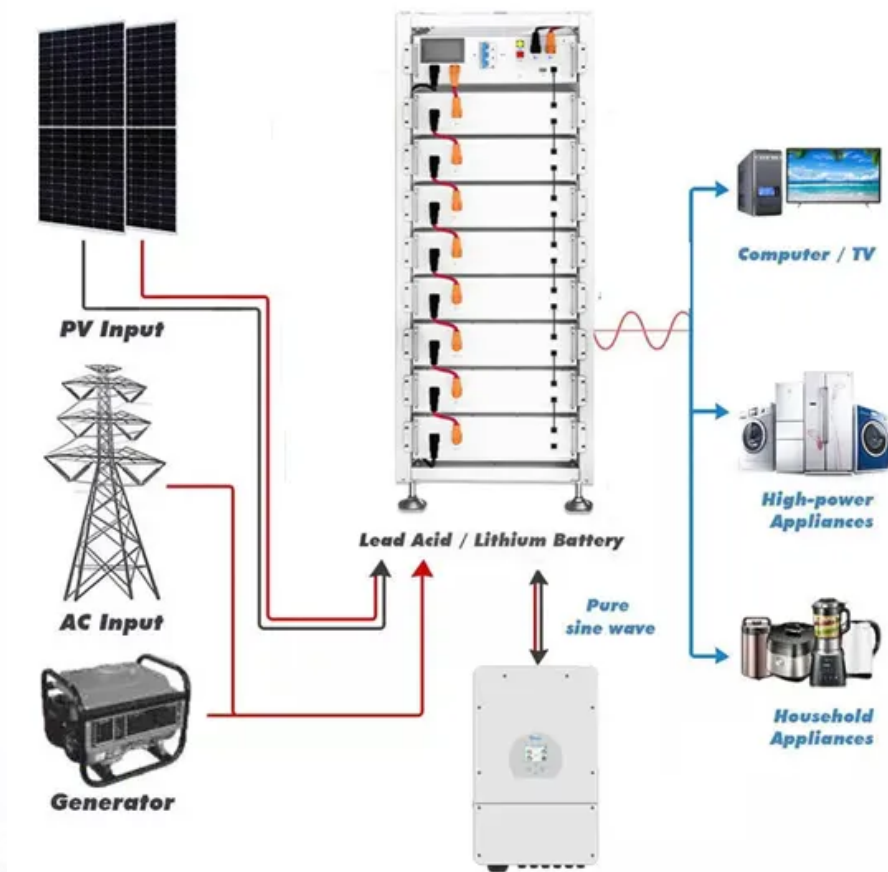

Energy transition in China: Assessing progress in sustainable

According to the IEA (2020), renewables (including biofuels, waste, hydro, wind and solar energy resources) in China accounted for about 19.5% of the total energy supply in 2000, while 80.5% was made of coal, natural gas, oil and nuclear. In 2019, the total energy supply increased by about 200% compared to 2000, with renewables accounting for about 9.8%.

At the same time, energy demand continues to grow rapidly, especially in developing countries, as they seek to lift billions out of poverty and drive economic growth [8]. 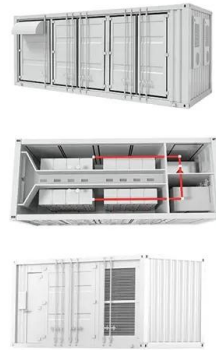

Unfortunately, the impacts of these policies are mostly limited to paper and the ground reality is far from what is targeted. For example, the total number of vehicles registered in Nepal until 2019 is 3.8 million out of which only ~50,000 (<1.4%) are electric vehicles, which are expensive compared to the petroleum counterparts and cannot be afforded by the general public.

Nepal's economy has witnessed a growth of 25.52% from the previous 4.2% GDP growth in the fiscal year 2020-2021 to 5.8% in 2021-2022. The economy of Nepal has flaunted a substantial growth of 4.25% in 2021 from a minus growth of -2.37% in 2020 (Pandey, 2022).
