Why do solar panels damage my roof?

Do solar panels protect your roof?

By blocking solar radiation from the roof itself, solar panels may also protect your roof from heat-related degradation. Keep in mind that older roofs will eventually need to be repaired or replaced, and doing so means taking down existing solar panels.

Can solar panels cause a roof to leak?

It's extremely rare that installing solar panels on your roof would cause a leak. Leaks only occur when the small holes drilled for mounting the solar panel brackets aren't sealed properly. On tin roofs, inadequate sealing could lead to erosion and leaks down the road.

Do solar panels compromise roof integrity?

Long-term solar panel presence may compromise roof integrity. The Good (Solutions) Proper sealant and flashing prevent water damage. Regular maintenance mitigates wear and extends lifespan. Which roof is a good candidate for solar panels?

South-facing roofs are usually the best candidates for solar panels because they will receive the most direct sunlight throughout the day. Roofs that slope

between 30 and 40 degrees are best positioned to collect the sun's rays. If a rooftop is partially or fully blocked by trees, it may not be a good candidate for solar panels.

How long do solar panels last on a roof?

Solar panels can last between 20 and 25 years, so if your current roof will not last that long, consider getting a new one before installing solar so the timing of replacing both systems matches up. Before you commit to having solar panels installed on your roof, there are several factors to take into consideration.

Solar panels add a lot of weight to your roof. A residential solar panel is about 40-50 pounds per panel or 5-6 pounds per square foot. Commercial solar panels are even bigger and heavier - about 50-60 pounds.

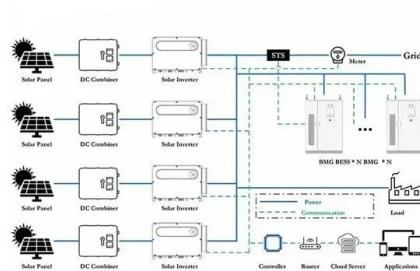
