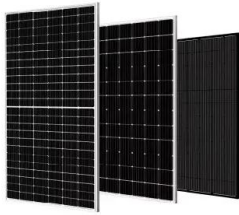

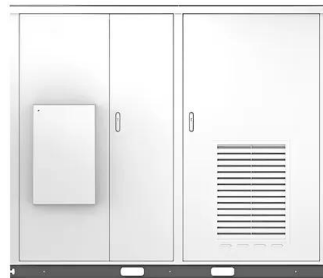

BP, Shell to start building 112-MW solar project in Trinidad and Tobago

The scheme is said to be Trinidad and Tobago's first commercial-scale renewable energy project.



It consists of the 92-MW AC/122-MWp Brechin Castle site and the 20-MW AC/26-MWp Orange Grove site, with the latter to include collaboration with the University of the West Indies (UWI).
