How to protect solar panels from hail?

Protecting solar panels from hail requires an automated solar panel angle system to provide continuous sunlight access in bad weather. Use a remote to adjust the surface exposure by changing the angle. Monitor the weather forecast for optimal panel protection in changing conditions.
