Make sure that any debris around the site where your solar power system was installed has been cleared away so there's no chance of anything getting thrown up into the panels. Clean your solar panels often to protect them from damage.

To protect against a direct strike, a lightning rod or some other lightning deterrent is highly recommended for people with solar panels in a high volume lightning area. 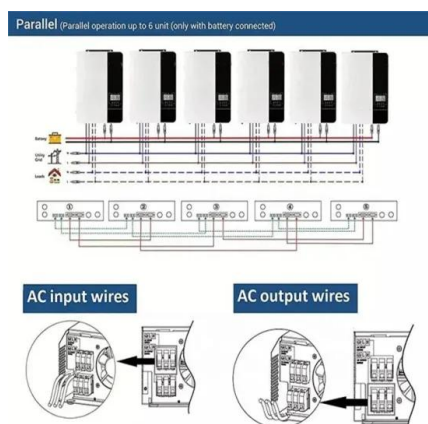
