What angle should solar panels be installed on a flat roof?

The ideal pitch for a Solar Panel is around 30 degrees off the horizontal. Simply because this allows the panels to gain more exposure from the sun

throughout the entire day. When installing Solar panels on a flat roof, this is easily achieved. As the Solar Panels are installed onto a bracket which tilts the panel to around 30 degrees.

How much do flat roof solar panels cost?

Flat roof solar panels can cost between £2,800 - £12,100 for the average 2 to 3 bedroom house. Flat roof solar panels cost less in terms of labour costs since installation is easier (however this depends on your roof). One downside of putting solar panels on a flat roof is that they take up more space per kW.
