Why can the wind curtain machine generate electricity by heat insulation



Overview

Do curtains keep heat out?

Don't forget that curtains work both ways: they can keep heat out as well as in. Drawing your curtains in summer is a great way to keep rooms cool and reduce the need for air conditioning.

Do Curtains need to be insulated?

So you need curtains that seal at the sides and reach snugly to the floor (or touch the windowsill). The more air you trap between the fabric and the window the better your curtains will be as heat insulators.

Can curtains reduce heat loss?

And do not underestimate the power of curtains. Drawing the blinds at dusk can reduce heat loss by 13-14 per cent and curtains from 15-17 per cent, Richard reveals. The university used to ask students to pretend to live in the house to create real-life conditions – to open and shut doors and windows as a real-life resident would.

Is glass curtain wall sustainable?

Glass curtain wall provides an attractive building envelope, but it is generally regarded as unsustainable because of the high energy needed to maintain thermal comfort. Why are curtains so important?

Remember that the purpose of curtains is not simply to give you privacy: good curtains should trap a significant volume of air between the fabric and the window and stop it from moving; it's the air that gives you the insulation and not (generally) the fabric of the curtains themselves.

Why do window curtains have a layer of cloth?

First, it reflects heat back into the room, so cutting losses by radiation. Second, the extra layer of cloth traps another insulating layer of air between itself and the main curtain. Third, it makes the entire curtain heavier, less likely to blow in the wind, and more likely to trap that all-important air curtain in front of the window.

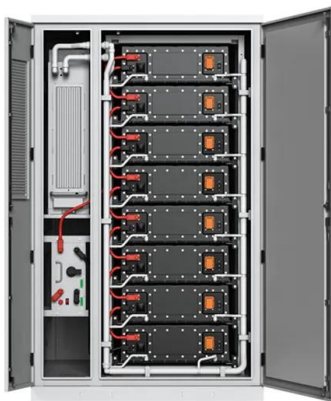
